Duration

Entry Requirements

There are no formal entry requirements to can register for this course. However, you must demonstrate to us that you have the experience, skills, knowledge, and capacity to achieve this qualification through our initial assessment process.

Qualification Structure

There's a total of 7 Units to achieve this qualification. The Mandatory Units included in this qualification are:

- Erecting and dismantling access/working platforms in the workplace
- Preparing surfaces for painting/decorating in the workplace
- Applying paint systems by brush and roller in the workplace
- Conforming to general health, safety and welfare in workplace
- Conforming to productive working practices in the workplace
- Moving, Handling and storing resources in the workplace

Candidates must also then complete 1 unit from the Optional Group Units:

- Operating equipment in support of the painter sprayer in the workplace
- Operating equipment in support of the abrasive blast cleaner in the workplace
- Applying coatings by the airless spray method in the workplace
- Preparing surfaces by the abrasive blast cleaning in the workplace
